2. **Approval of the Agenda** Motion to approve D. Gorman, second by C. Zastrow. Motion Approved.
3. **Approval of the minutes from April 3, 2017 meeting** Motion to approve K. Maier, second by P. Nievinski, K. Theil abstained. Motion Approved.

New Business

4. **Extended Field Trip Request**
 - a. Orlando, FL - Campbell, Students will leave on Dec 26, 2017 and will return on New Year's Eve. Cost is \$900 per student. The trip will be a large marching band performance at the Russell Athletic Field, Mosinee School District will be one of several schools that would perform during halftime. Motion to approve by D. Gorman, second by N. Pasha. Further discussion by K. Theil about the cost and what, if any provisions are made for students to attend who may not be able to afford the trip. Dick relayed that there are several options and no student has to date been turned away due to financial concerns. Motion Approved.
 - b. Minneapolis MN - Trip will be to the Minneapolis Orchestra, the students will be able to attend rehearsal and the concert. Students will leave Feb 6, 2018 early morning and will return Feb 6, 2018 late in the evening. Approximately 40 students will attend and it will cost \$40 per student. Motion to approve by P. 5. **Review of Extended Field Trip to Costa Rica** - 20 students from Mosinee went on the trip to Costa Rica, and 16 students from DC Everest and three chaperones. Students experienced the Manuel Antonio National Park, and were able to walk through the

rainforest as well as spend time at the ocean. They prepared an authentic Costa Rican lunch with the tour guide's family.. They travelled to both the Carara National Park Hike and Aerial Tram. They also got to go to the Ox Cart Factory for painting lessons. On the last day, they were able to go white water rafting. and were able to visit a local school and interact with the kids.

6. Academic and Career Planning - Academic and Career Planning is a student-driven, adult- supported program. It helps to keep students more motivated and decreases risk-taking behaviors. In the MS, in grade 6, students start doing activities to start the process of getting to know themselves, explore their interests and begin planning for their futures. Career cruising is a software that is used from grade 6-12, students revisit it from year to year to see what their interests might be as they get older.
