Dear Mosinee Community,

I want to thank you for helping our school district educate the children of Mosinee. I truly believe that our partnership with our families and our community is what allows us to service the educational needs of our children well. Without dedicated parents, aunts, uncles, grandparents, neighbors, and *all* Mosinee citizens, our schools would not be strong for our children. I thank you for taking pride in our Mosinee Schools and for helping us do one of the most important jobs we have as a community; to teach our children.

Part of our challenge in educating our youth is not only supporting their learning needs, but also providing quality facilities for their learning to occur. Our Elementary School was built in 1975 and has had additions/renovations in 1993 and 2007. Originally built in 1922, our Middle School has had additions/renovations in 1939, 1969, 1985, and 1996. Our High School facility, built in 1960, has had 1965 and 1996 additions. Surprisingly, our most recent addition/renovations including the Creske Center occurred nearly **20** years ago! It is hard to believe how quickly time passes. We are grateful for the Mosinee Community support for continuing to keep our facilities up to date. As you can imagine when your facilities range in age from 1922-1996, we face many challenges trying to maintain our buildings.

To better understand the state of our facilities, we hired CESA 10, which is a Cooperative Educational Support Agency, to bring in their team of engineers to conduct a facility audit of all of our Mosinee School District facilities. We now need your help! Our facility audit report is filled with great information that needs to be further analyzed and prioritized for our school district so that our Board of Education can make informed facility decisions. As a member of the Mosinee community, we value your ideas, we value your thoughts, and we value your input. I would like to invite *you* to be part of our Facility Committee and work with our team to develop both a short and long term plan for our school facilities. We have contracted with Blue Design, an architectural firm that is owned by Steve Jamroz and Steve Romatz, to help us facilitate and guide our committees work.

We have scheduled our first committee meeting for **Wednesday, September 9, 2015 from 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm** in the Creske Center. During that meeting, we will share an outline of the work ahead along with specific meeting dates that will include 1-2 Wednesday night meetings per month during September, October, November, and December.
