2022-2023 School Calendar Approved; Summer School 2022; **Congratulations Winter Sports Teams**

The Mosinee School Board approved the 2022-2023 school calendar which can be found on the district website: mosineeschools.org - District - Calendars. The Mosinee School District will start the new school year September 1, 2022 and end on June 2, 2023, with graduation for the Class of 2023 (current Juniors) on May 26, 2023. One major calendar change to note is having the entire week of Thanksgiving off as a late fall break. We were able to create a calendar that allowed for this break when many are in the woods and/ or preparing for the holiday season while maintaining a full week of spring break that aligned with several of the larger

surrounding school districts. The Class of 2022 (current Seniors) graduates May 27, 2022. The Senior Class, like all of our students, endured and persevered through several years of a pandemic. All of our students, families and staff deserve special recognition for not only maintaining a commitment to in-person learning at high-levels academically but also through activities at the school forest, dances, sports, clubs, internships, dual college credit opportunities, and work.

Mosinee will be holding summer school again this year. Information packets will be sent home with students at the beginning of April. An email will be sent to parents the week of April 18th so a parent can log on to the summer school registration site to ensure they have access prior to registration. Mosinee's winter sports teams surged to the top including Boys Hockey winning the Conference Tournament and Regional Championship; Girls Hockey remained top seeded heading into the WIAA playoffs; Girls Basketball won the GNC Conference Championship and #1 seed going into WIAA playoffs, ranked top 10 in the state; Boys Basketball won the GNC Conference and #2 seed for the WIAA playoffs; Wrestling advanced 4 competitors to the Sectional Tournament; Gymnastics is currently second in the conference moving into the tournament season; the Dance Team went to state for the second time in school history in consecutive years and were Regional Champs in Hip-Hop and Runners-up in Pom. Congratulations to all participants on a great winter season!

Grant Awarded for Field Lights at Edgewood Park

In February, the Mosinee Soccer Booster Club, in partnership with the Mosinee Community Athletic Association (MCAA), received a tourism grant for \$109,000 to install lights at Edgewood Park.

The project began with **Van Ert Electric Company** and **Newton Electric** Corp. collaborating on a design for state-of-the-art stadium lights at Edgewood Park. The booster club then took that plan to the Mosinee Parks and Recreation Commission for approval. After receiving the go-ahead, friends of the Mosinee Soccer Booster Club and several coaches completed and submitted the grant paperwork, while also partnering with the MCAA. Their efforts paid off when the boosters received word that the grant was being awarded for a portion of the lighting project. There is still much to be done before the installation begins. The Mosinee Soccer Booster Club is looking for additional partners to secure the remaining funds needed to make this project happen. Open Enrollment Dates

February 7 - April 29, 2022

The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) has announced the dates for public school Open Enrollment for the 2022-23 school year. Children in 5-year-old kindergarten through grade 12 may participate. Open enrollment for prekindergarten, 4K and early childhood education is limited. Parents with children in these age groups must contact their resident school district to see if their children are eligible. If you would like your child to attend a different public school next year, you must apply to the school district of choice between February 7 and April 29, 2022. Applications must be received by 4:00 pm on April 29, 2022. Late applications will not be accepted. Parents may apply online at https://dpi.wi.gov/oe. 4K Registration Now Open For 2022-23 School Year

The enrollment process is now open for any students entering 4K (4-year-old kindergarten) for the 2022-23 school year. Children who are four years old on or before September 1, 2022 are eligible to register.

The 4K web page (https://www.mosineeschools.org/families/4K Information.cfm) on the Mosinee School District website provides an overview of the 4K program and also step-by-step registration instructions. The first and most important step is registering your child in Mosinee's Skyward Family Access. Busing transportation forms and site preference requests can also be completed at this time.

2022-23 Kindergarten Registration

Students currently attending 4K in the Mosinee School District will automatically be enrolled in five-year-old kindergarten at Mosinee Elementary School for the 2022-23 school year. A letter will be mailed in August to all parents/guardians of incoming five-year-olds confirming their teacher assignment and other important information for the upcoming school year.

Summer School Opportunities

The Mosinee School District is once again providing fun and engaging learning opportunities in the upcoming summer school program. Two sessions will be offered: **Session 1: June 13-30** and Session 2: July 11-28. (Classes will not be in session the week of July 4th.) Classes are Monday-Thursday, 7:50 am - 12 noon, unless otherwise noted.

Students entering kindergarten this fall will register for Kickoff to Kindergarten while 1st graders will register for Fun in First Grade.
