

Mosinee School District
Special Board of Education Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, August 30, 2016

Michael Kaiser, School Board President, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Roll call of Directors: Gewiss, Krautkramer, Kaiser, Ahles, Gorman, Barnes, Tomczyk, Zebro, and Thiel.

Pledge of Allegiance...

Everyone stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Agenda...

Motion by Tomczyk, seconded by Gewiss, to approve the agenda, as posted. Voice vote revealed 9 yes and 0 no. Motion carried unanimously.

Public Forum...

No one addressed the Board during Public Forum.

Discussion and Possible Decision: Approval of Adding a Four Year Old Kindergarten Section/Teacher at the Elementary School...

Superintendent Schultz explained that there were approximately seven students looking for a place to attend 4K because the four community sites are full for the 2016-17 school year and none of the sites are interested in adding an additional class. She indicated that she is double checking with those families to see if they would be interested in sending their child to 4K if it was offered at the elementary school.

The cost for adding a half-time teacher for the class is \$21,530.00 for salary and benefits, and the school district would be reimbursed some of the money by the State if there were at least ten students enrolled.


Schultz clarified the differences between the preschool and 4K programs, and Brent Zimmerman reported that Mosinee's 4K program has been in existence for eight years with this year being the largest.

Motion by Gewiss, seconded by Tomczyk, to approve moving forward in adding a Four Year Old Kindergarten Section and Teacher at the Elementary School with the seven students interested. Additional discussion covered whether or not the program would continue if there weren't seven interested, or if the number fell below seven. Gewiss amended his motion to approve moving forward with five interested students. Tomczyk seconded the amended motion. Voice vote revealed 9 yes and 0 no. Motion carried unanimously.

Adjournment...

Motion by Ahles, seconded by Tomczyk, to adjourn. Roll call vote revealed 9 yes: Kaiser, Ahles, Gorman, Krautkramer, Barnes, Gewiss, Thiel, Tomczyk, and Zebro, and 0 no. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
