1. ACPs are Academic Career Plans that all students grades 6-12 have as <u>individual</u> students, required by the state.

2. The MISSION of ACPs is to empower ALL students to *actively participate* in future planning through education and training to careers.

 Students ENGAGE in activities meant to help them learn about themselves, career and college possibilities, and planning steps for their future path.


### **Dual Credit**





## **Peer Mentorship Groups**
