The Mosinee School District will be continuing the Feeding Our Future Food Program this year. Our food pantry provides Mosinee School District students in need with food for the weekend. The program runs the entire school year and there is no cost to participate.

If your student(s) is in need of receiving a food bag on the weekends for the 2023-2024 school year, please fill out the information below and return it to your child's school office. Once the program is implemented, your child will receive a bag of food every Friday which will be distributed in a discreet and caring manner. If you have a need for larger family items, we encourage you to reach out to the Community Center of Hope, or the Circle of Joy. Both are located in Mosinee. **If you sign-up for this program, please talk with your child and inform them that this food is intended to be eaten at home and not at school or on a school bus.**
