Advanced Placement (AP) and Dual credit courses give students access to a wide variety of college-level classes for all future pathways including four-year universities, two-year tech schools, or classes that yield certifications for direct entry to the workforce. In the Northcentral Technical College region, no other high school provides more dual credit classes within their building or has students take advantage of these opportunities at a higher rate.

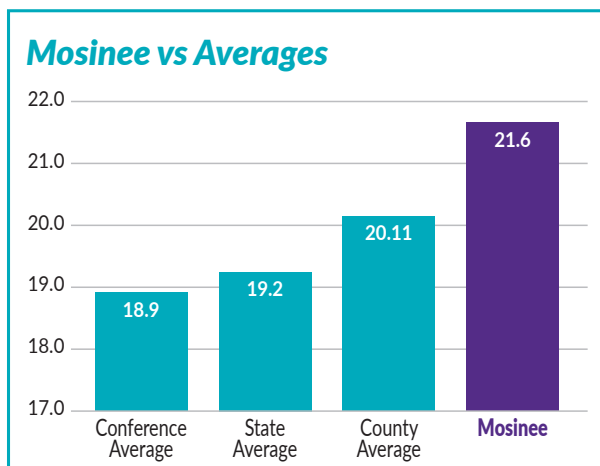

Student Achievement

Mosinee High School students routinely test above all comparable averages. The students in the class of 2025 earned a composite score of 21.6 on the ACT test, giving them the top score in Marathon County, the Great Northern Conference, and well above the state average. Mosinee prides itself on its academic rigor, well established and recognized teaching staff which allows our students to continually display strong academic achievement.
