Is a program designed for the student to work with a Employer Mentor on specific skills in one of the 11 Programs. You are required to work 450 hours in a calendar year and successfully complete the competencies required.

3) Once you have employment complete the ETA and Registration forms provided on the Mosinee School to Work webpage and turn them into Mr. Lindsey

4. If you don't have privileges you must provide your work schedule to study hall prior to attending work or you will be unexcused.

5) Check your school email daily and respond within 48 hours.
